10	A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
11	designated §61-2-8a, relating to making it illegal to transport a minor across state lines to
12	obtain an abortion without written consent of both parents or legal guardians; and providing
13	a penalty.
14	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
15	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new
16	section, designated §61-2-8a, to read as follows:
17	ARTICLE 2. CRIMES AGAINST THE PERSON.
18	§61-2-8a. Transporting a minor across state lines for an abortion; penalty.
19	A person who transports a minor across state lines to obtain an abortion, without the written
20	consent of both parents or the legal guardians of the minor, is guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon
21	conviction, shall be fined not less than \$500 nor more than \$1,000, or confined in jail not more
22	than six months, or both fined and confined.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to make it a misdemeanor to transport a minor across state lines to obtain an abortion without written consent by both parents or her legal guardians.

This section is new; therefore, it has been completely underscored.
