INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS - REGIONAL AIRPORTS. 17 §8-29-4. Management of authority vested in members; appointment and terms of members; 18 vote of members; valuation of property contributed to an authority; 19 participation by additional municipalities or counties without state. 20 (a) The management and control of each authority, its property, operations, business and affairs shall be lodged in a board of not less than five nor more than twenty-one individuals who 22 shall be known as members of the authority and who shall be appointed for terms of three years each

1 by the municipalities and county courts commissions contributing moneys or property to the authority. However, the first board shall be comprised of one member appointed by each participating municipality and one member appointed by each participating county court commission, and any such member shall serve a term of one year, beginning as of the date the authority is created. No more than three members shall may serve from one county on the first board. 6 (b) Each municipality or county shall have one vote for each \$5,000 dollars it has contributed to the authority in the form of moneys or property. When property is contributed, the contributing municipality or county court and the authority shall agree in writing at the time the contribution is made as to the fair market value of such property, which valuation shall determine the number of votes to be allocated to the municipality or county on the basis thereof. For the fiscal year during which any authority is formed, the number of votes to which any municipality or county shall be 12 entitled shall be determined as of the time of formation of the authority and shall govern until the 13 end of that fiscal year, even though additional moneys or property are contributed during that fiscal year. Thereafter, the number of votes shall be determined at the end of each fiscal year and such determination shall govern for the ensuing fiscal year, even though additional moneys or property 16 are contributed during that fiscal year. Subsequent to its formation, any authority may permit any 17 municipality or county without this state to participate in the affairs of the authority, to appoint members of the authority in the same manner, and to have such vote or votes beginning as of the next ensuing fiscal year, as prescribed by law with respect to the original participating municipalities or 20 counties or any combination thereof. The county seat of the county in which the airport is situated, or alternatively, the municipality in which the airport is situated shall appoint two members to the 22 authority and each county where the airport and facilities are located shall appoint five members to

- 1 the authority. All other participating counties may appoint one member to the authority. If the
- 2 authority has a number of members which is an even number, the county where the majority of the
- 3 airport facilities are located shall appoint one additional member to the authority to provide for an
- 4 odd number of members.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to clarify how members of regional airport authority boards are to be allocated.
