Eye drop prescription refills. 19 Any accident and sickness insurance policy issued by an insurer pursuant to this article that covers prescription eye drops to prevent potentially blinding or debilitating eye diseases, may not 21 deny coverage for a refill of the prescription if: 22 (1) The refill is requested by the insured:

1	(A) For a thirty day supply, between twenty-one and thirty days from the later of:
2	(i) The original date the prescription was distributed to the insured; or
3	(ii) The date the most recent refill was distributed to the insured; and
4	(B) For a sixty day supply, between forty-two and sixty days from the later of:
5	(i) The original date the prescription was distributed to the insured; or
6	(ii) The date the most recent refill was distributed to the insured; and
7	(C) For a ninety day supply, between sixty-three and ninety days from the later of:
8	(i) The original date the prescription was distributed to the insured; or
9	(ii) The date the most recent refill was distributed to the insured; and
10	(2) The prescription eye drops prescribed by the practitioner are a covered benefit under the
11	policy or contract of the insured; and
12	(3) The prescribing practitioner indicates on the original prescription that additional
13	quantities of the prescription eye drops are needed; and
14	(4) The refill requested by the insured does not exceed the number of additional quantities
15	needed.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require refill of eye drop prescriptions within certain time frames.
