14	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
15	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new
16	section, designated §12-6D-7, to read as follows:
17	ARTICLE 6D. WEST VIRGINIA ENTERPRISE RESOURCE PLANNING BOARD.
18	§12-6D-7. Exemptions.
19	Beginning July 1, 2015, the following agencies and institutions are excluded from all current
20	and future obligations to the West Virginia Enterprise Resource Planning Board, also known as
21	WVOASIS:

1 (24) West Virginia University Parkersburg.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to lessen the financial impact of attempting to incorporate a system that does not properly interface with the agencies and institutions' current systems.
