19	The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 1, 2013, authorized under the
20	authority of section seven, article five, chapter thirty of this code, modified by the Board of
21	Pharmacy to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in

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1 the State Register on January 8, 2015, relating to the Board of Pharmacy (controlled substances

2 monitoring, <u>15 CSR 8</u>), is authorized.
