10	A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
11	designated §15-5-6a, relating to school nutrition standards during a state of emergency or
12	state of preparedness; authorizing Governor or Legislature to temporarily suspend legislative
13	rules establishing nutrition standards for foods and beverages served to students in public
14	schools during a state of emergency or state of preparedness; and providing limitations.
15	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
16	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new
17	section, designated §15-5-6a, to read as follows:
18	ARTICLE 5. DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY
19	MANAGEMENT.
20	§15-5-6a. Temporary suspension of nutrition standards in public schools.
21	This section is operative only during the existence of a state of emergency or state of
22	preparedness proclaimed by the Governor or by concurrent resolution of the Legislature. During a

state of emergency or state of preparedness, the Governor or the Legislature may, to facilitate
uninterrupted days of instruction, temporarily suspend legislative rules establishing nutrition
standards for foods and beverages distributed to students in public schools during the school day:
Provided, That safe alternative foods and beverages are available for distribution to students, and
the temporary suspension of nutrition standards permitted by this section is limited to the geographic
area impacted by the state of emergency or state of preparedness.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to facilitate educational instruction during a state of emergency or state of preparedness where approved school meals are not available for distribution to students, but safe alternative meals are available for distribution.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
