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10	A BILL to amend and reenact §18-2-25 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
11	to requiring the West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission to promulgate rules
12	that allow college preparatory team to elect to be recognized as a member; and setting forth

14	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
15	That §18-2-25 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted
16	to read as follows:
17	ARTICLE 2. STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION.
18	§18-2-25. Authority of county boards to regulate athletic and other extracurricular activities
19	of secondary schools; delegation of authority to West Virginia Secondary School
20	Activities Commission; authority of commission; approval of rules by state
21	board; incorporation; funds; participation by private and parochial schools.
22	(a) The county boards of education are hereby granted and shall exercise the control,
23	supervision and regulation of all interscholastic athletic events, and other extracurricular activities
24	of the students in public secondary schools, and of $\frac{1}{1}$ those schools $\frac{1}{1}$ their respective counties.
25	The county board of education may delegate such control, supervision and regulation of
26	interscholastic athletic events and band activities to the "West Virginia Secondary School Activities

1 Commission," which is hereby established.

2 (b) The West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission shall be composed of the principals, or their representatives, of those secondary schools whose county boards of education have certified in writing to the State Superintendent of Schools that they have elected to delegate the control, supervision and regulation of their interscholastic athletic events and band activities of the students in the public secondary schools in their respective counties to said the commission. The West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission is hereby empowered to may exercise the control, supervision and regulation of interscholastic athletic events and band activities of secondary schools, delegated to it pursuant to this section. The rules and regulations of the West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission shall contain a provision for a proper review procedure and review board and be promulgated in accordance with the provisions of chapter twenty-nine-a of this code, but shall, in all instances be subject to the prior approval of the state board. The West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission, may, with the consent of the State Board of Education, incorporate under the name of "West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission, Inc.," as a nonprofit, nonstock corporation under the provisions of chapter thirty-one of this code. County boards of education are hereby authorized to may expend moneys for and pay dues to the West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission, and all moneys paid to such the commission, as well as moneys derived from any contest or other event sponsored by said the commission, shall be are quasi-public funds as the same are defined in article five, chapter eighteen of this code, and such the funds of the commission shall be are subject to an annual audit by the State 21 Tax Commissioner. 22 (c) The West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission shall promulgate reasonable rules and regulations providing for the control, supervision and regulation of the interscholastic athletic events and other extracurricular activities of such private and parochial secondary schools as that elect to delegate to such the commission such control, supervision and regulation, upon the

same terms and conditions, subject to the same regulations rules and requirements and upon the

- 1 payment of the same fees and charges as those provided for public secondary schools. Any such
- 2 private or parochial secondary school shall receive any monetary or other benefits in the same
- 3 manner and in the same proportion as any public secondary school.
- 4 (d) The West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission shall promulgate reasonable
- 5 rules pursuant to this section that allow a college preparatory team to elect to be recognized as a
- 6 member of the West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission. The rules shall:
- 7 (1) Limit recognition of college preparatory teams as members of the West Virginia
- 8 Secondary School Activities Commission to only those college preparatory teams that require its
- 9 students to attend a school which has elected to delegate control pursuant to subsections (b) and (c)
- 10 of this section and that require all of its students to attend the same school;
- 11 (2) Prohibit a college preparatory team recognized as a member of the West Virginia
- 12 Secondary School Activities Commission from competing for league, regional or state
- 13 championships;
- 14 (3) Prohibit a college preparatory team recognized as a member of the West Virginia
- 15 Secondary School Activities Commission from having fifth-year seniors or post-high school graduate
- 16 student athletes on its roster; and
- 17 (4) Require a college preparatory team recognized as a member of the West Virginia
- 18 Secondary School Activities Commission to play a limited schedule in each sanctioned sport against
- 19 schools that have elected to delegate control pursuant to subsections (b) and (c) of this section.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require the West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission to promulgate rules that allow a college preparatory team to elect to be recognized as a member.
