1 A BILL to amend and reenact §5A-3-50 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
2 to a moratorium on state vehicle purchases.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

1 That §5A-3-50 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and
2 reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 3. PURCHASING DIVISION.

§5A-3-50. Acquiring and disposing of vehicles and aircraft.

1 The secretary shall be empowered to purchase new vehicles and aircraft and dispose of
2 old vehicles and aircraft as is practical from time to time: Provided, That the secretary, or his or
3 her designee, shall not purchase any new or used vehicle on behalf of the state from July 1, 2016,
4 to June 30, 2017.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to put a one-year moratorium on state vehicle purchases.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
