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1 A BILL to repeal §16-5P-7 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended; and to repeal §29-2 12C-1 and §29-12C-2; all relating to eliminating obsolete government entities; repealing 3 section relating to the West Virginia Council on Aging; repealing sections relating to the 4 Patient Injury Compensation Plan Study Board. Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia: 1 That §16-5P-7 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be repealed; and that 2 §29-12C-1 and §29-12C-2 of said code, be repealed. 3 §1. Repeal of section relating to the West Virginia Council on Aging. 4 §16-5P-7 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, is hereby repealed. 5 §2. Repeal of article relating to the Patient Injury Compensation Plan Study Board. 6 §29-12C-1 and §29-12C-2 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, are 7 hereby repealed.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to eliminate the West Virginia Council on Aging and the Patient Injury Compensation Plan Study Board, because they are unnecessary, inactive or redundant.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
