A BILL to amend and reenact §15-1F-8 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
to the reemployment rights of military personnel; extending reemployment rights protection
to members of the organized militia in the active service of another state; and clarifying
that the Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment Rights Act of 1994 is
considered applicable federal law.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §15-1F-8 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 1F. PRIVILEGES AND PROHIBITIONS.

§15-1F-8. Reemployment rights of members of the organized militia.

Members of the organized militia in the active service of the state <u>or another state</u> shall be entitled to the same reemployment rights granted to members of the reserve components of the Armed Forces of the United States by applicable federal law, <u>including rights protected by the Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment Rights Act of 1994 (USERRA), as amended, 38 U. S. C. §§ 4301-4334.</u>
