- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
- 2 designated §11-21-10b, relating to providing a \$500 tax credit to volunteer firefighters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

- 1 That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new
- 2 section, designated §11-21-10b, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 21. PERSONAL INCOME TAX.

§11-21-10b. Tax credit for certain volunteer firefighters.

- 1 Any volunteer firefighter who has up-to-date credentials for the taxable year and has
- 2 responded to at least five verified calls in the year is entitled to a credit against his or her
- 3 personal income tax for that year in the amount of \$500.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide a \$500 tax credit to volunteer firefighters who have responded to at least five verified calls in a year.

§11-21-10b is new; therefore, it has been completely underscored.
