#### H.B. 2532

A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
designated §11-21-12j, relating to providing certain members of volunteer fire departments
and rescue squads a \$5,000 modification reducing federal adjusted gross income for
personal income tax purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

1 That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new

2 section, designated §11-21-12j, to read as follows:

#### ARTICLE 21. PERSONAL INCOME TAX.

### <u>§11-21-12j.</u> Additional modification reducing federal adjusted gross income for volunteer <u>fire department and rescue squad members.</u>

1 (a) In addition to amounts authorized to be subtracted from federal adjusted gross income

- 2 pursuant to other sections of this article, a \$5,000 modification reducing federal adjusted gross
- 3 income is authorized for an active or auxiliary member of a volunteer fire department or rescue
- 4 squad if:
- 5 <u>(1) The member has:</u>
- 6 (A) Successfully completed the minimum training requirements of the West Virginia
- 7 University fire service extension firefighter training, section one, or its equivalent, and other training
- 8 required by the State Fire Commission; or
- 9 (B) Has received a certification as an emergency medical service personnel, under article
- 10 <u>four-c, chapter sixteen of this code;</u>
- 11 (2) The volunteer fire department or rescue squad has provided workers' compensation
- 12 coverage for the member during the year; and
- 13 (3) The member is on active status in the volunteer fire department as verified by the
- 14 president and chief of the volunteer fire department or the president and captain of the volunteer

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- 15 rescue squad.
- 16 (b) The Tax Commissioner shall promulgate procedural rules providing the procedure a
- 17 member of a volunteer fire department and rescue squad must use to establish that the member
- 18 is qualified for the modification provided in this section.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to allow members of volunteer fire departments and rescue squads who have successfully completed required training and are covered by workers' compensation a \$5,000 modification reducing federal adjusted gross income for personal income tax purposes.

This section is new; therefore, it has been completely underscored.
