### **House Bill 4110**

1 A BILL to amend and reenact article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as  
2 amended, relating to authorizing the Department of Health and Human Resources to  
3 promulgate a legislative rule relating to farmers market vendors.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

1 That article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended  
2 and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN  
RESOURCES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-5-1. Department of Health and Human Resources.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 27, 2015, authorized under the  
2 authority of section four, article thirty-five, chapter nineteen, of this code, modified by the  
3 Department of Health and Human Resources to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-  
4 making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on October 23, 2015, relating to the  
5 Department of Health and Human Resources (farmers market vendors, 64 CSR 102), is  
6 authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Farmers Market Vendors.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
