### **House Bill 4132**

1 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as  
2 amended, relating to authorizing the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule  
3 relating to the licensure of wholesale drug distributors, third-party logistics providers and  
4 manufacturers.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

1 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended  
2 and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS  
TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. Board of Pharmacy .**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 16, 2015, authorized under the  
2 authority of section seven, article five, chapter thirty, of this code, modified by the Board of  
3 Pharmacy to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in  
4 the State Register on December 17, 2015, relating to the Board of Pharmacy (licensure of  
5 wholesale drug distributors, third-party logistics providers and manufacturers, 15 CSR 5), is  
6 authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the Licensure of Wholesale Drug Distributors, Third-Party Logistics Providers and Manufacturers.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
