1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,  
 2 designated §59-1-2c, relating to the voluntary deposit of refunds for the overpayment of  
 3 fees to the Children's Trust Fund.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

1 That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new  
 2 section, designated §59-1-2c, to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 1. FEES AND ALLOWANCES.**

**§59-1-2c. Voluntary donation of certain refunds.**

1 The Secretary of State shall provide a mechanism by which any overpayment of \$25 or  
 2 less of any fee authorized by this or any other chapter of this code to the Secretary of State may  
 3 be deposited in the West Virginia Children's Trust Fund authorized by section one, article six-c,  
 4 chapter forty-nine of this code: *Provided*, That any person due a refund of \$25 or less for  
 5 overpayment of fees must voluntarily and affirmatively choose for such refund to be deposited in  
 6 the West Virginia Children's Trust Fund.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to allow a voluntary donation of refunds for overpayment of fees to the Secretary of State's office to the West Virginia Children's Trust Fund.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
