- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
- 2 designated §24A-2-7, relating to exempting taxicab companies whose drivers are
- 3 independent contractors from providing workers' compensation coverage for the drivers.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

- 1 That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new
- 2 section, designated §24A-2-7, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 2. COMMON CARRIERS BY MOTOR VEHICLES.

§24A-2-7. Workers' compensation coverage.

- A taxicab company operating under this chapter is not required to provide workers'
- 2 compensation coverage to a driver who provides taxicab service pursuant to a written or electronic
- 3 agreement that identifies the taxicab driver as an independent contractor and any such taxi driver
- 4 identified as an independent contractor pursuant to this section shall not be eligible for workers'
- 5 compensation benefits under chapter twenty-three of this code as an employee of the taxicab
- 6 company.
