- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
- 2 designated §1-2-2a, relating to requiring the election by divisions in House of Delegates'
- 3 districts that have two or more delegates.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

- 1 That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new
- 2 section, designated §1-2-2a, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 2. APPORTIONMENT OF REPRESENTATION.

§1-2-2a. Divisions for multimember delegate districts.

- 1 Beginning with the 2018 elections, in every delegate district having two or more delegates
- 2 there are numbered divisions corresponding to the number of delegates in each district. Each
- 3 <u>delegate shall be elected at large from the entire district</u>. In each numbered division of a delegate
- 4 district, the candidates for nomination or election shall be voted on and the votes cast for the
- 5 candidates in each division shall be tallied separately from the votes cast for candidates in other
- 6 <u>numbered divisions within the district</u>. The candidate receiving the highest number of the votes
- 7 cast within a numbered division is nominated or elected, as the case may be.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require election by divisions in House of Delegates' districts that have two or more delegates.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
