- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1, of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to authorizing the Board of Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Licensing
- and Disciplinary Procedures: Physicians; Podiatrists.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

- 1 That §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted
- 2 to read as follows:

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. Board of Medicine.

- The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 12, 2016, authorized under the
- 4 authority of section seven, article three, chapter thirty of this code, modified by the Board of
- 5 Medicine to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in
- 6 the State Register on September 1, 2016, relating to the Board of Medicine (Licensing and
- 7 Disciplinary Procedures: Physicians; Podiatrists, 11 CSR 1A), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Licensing and Disciplinary Procedures: Physicians; Podiatrists.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
