- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia,1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
- 2 designated §30-27-15, relating to allowing schools licensed to provide barber,
- 3 cosmetology and related training to hold theory classes and clinical classes at different
- 4 locations.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

- 1 That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new
- 2 section, designated §30-27-15, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 27. BOARD OF BARBERS AND COSMETOLOGISTS.

§30-27-15. Schools may provide certain classes at different locations.

- 1 <u>A licensed school may provide clinical instruction and theory instruction in separate</u>
- 2 locations.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to allow schools licensed to provide barber, cosmetology and related training to hold theory classes and clinical classes at different locations.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
