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1 AN ACT to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section. 2 designated §5F-1-5, relating to the requirement that all executive branch agencies 3 maintain a website that contains specific information. Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia: 1 That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new 2 section, designated §5F-1-5, to read as follows: **ARTICLE 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS** §5F-1-5. Website content and required information. 1 Beginning December 31, 2017, each agency shall maintain a website that provides the 2 following information, if applicable; 3 (1) The office contact information, including office location and mailing address, telephone 4 number, facsimile number, office hours and electronic mail address; 5 (2) The contact information of each staff member, including office location and mailing 6 address, office telephone number, facsimile number and electronic mail address; 7 (3) Organizational chart; 8 (4) Administrative agency officials; 9 (5) A list of governing statutes and legislative and procedural rules: 10 (6) Meeting minutes; 11 (7) Annual reports;

(8) All agency forms, including application forms, complaint forms and instructions; and

(9) Frequently asked questions and descriptive answers.
