INTRODUCED H.B.

- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
- 2 designated §7-8-11a, relating to deduction from jail sentence for litter cleanup:

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

- 1 That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new
- 2 section, designated §7-8-11a, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 8. JAIL AND JAILER.

§7-8-11a. Deduction from sentence for litter cleanup.

- 1 At the discretion of the County Commission of the county in which a violation occurred,
- 2 and which in the judgment of the commission has litter to be cleaned up, a nonviolent offender
- 3 sentenced to jail may have one day of his or her sentence deducted for each day the offender
- 4 participates in cleaning up litter in the county. To be eligible, the offender shall faithfully comply
- 5 with all rules and regulations of the jail during the term of confinement.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide for sentence reduction of jail inmates who participate in cleaning up litter.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
