- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
- designated §30-1-5a, relating to the reporting of fraud, misappropriation of moneys, and
- 3 other violations of law to the commission on special investigations.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated §30-1-5a, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS APPLICABLE TO ALL STATE BOARDS OF EXAMINATION OR REGISTRATION REFERRED TO IN CHAPTER.

§30-1-5a. Reporting of fraud and misappropriation of funds.

- 1 (a) Whenever a board referred to in this chapter obtains information that an employee,
- 2 officer or member of the board may have misappropriated funds, engaged in fraud, or otherwise
- 3 violated a law relating to the public trust, the board shall timely report such information or
- 4 allegation in writing to the Commission on Special Investigations, established in article five,
- 5 chapter four.
- 6 (b) The reporting of such information under subsection (a) of this section shall not prevent,
- 7 <u>relieve or replace a report to a law-enforcement agency, if appropriate or warranted.</u>

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require the reporting of fraud and misappropriation of funds to the Legislature's Commission on Special Investigations.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
