Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

1 That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new

2 section, designated §48-9-605, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 9. ALLOCATION OF CUSTODIAL RESPONSIBILITY AND DECISION-MAKING RESPONSIBILITY OF CHILDREN.

§48-9-605. Visitation on Mother's Day and Father's Day.

- A child's mother may petition the court for visitation on Mother's Day and the father may
- 2 petition the court for visitation on Father's Day.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to permit parents to petition the court for visitation on Mother's Day and Father's Day.
