## **Senate Bill 119**

- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-5-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to authorizing the Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative
- 3 rule relating to clinical laboratory technician and technologist licensure and certification.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

- 1 That §64-5-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted
- 2 to read as follows:

# ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN RESOURCES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

#### §64-5-1. Department of Health and Human Resources.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 26, 2016, authorized under the
- 2 authority of section ten, article five-j, chapter sixteen of this code, modified by the Department of
- 3 Health and Human Resources to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review
- 4 Committee and refiled in the State Register on October 6, 2016, relating to the Department of
- 5 Health and Human Resources (Clinical Laboratory Technician and Technologist Licensure and
- 6 Certification, 64 CSR 57), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Clinical Laboratory Technician and Technologist Licensure and Certification.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law, and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
