- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to authorizing the Board of Osteopathic Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating
- 3 to licensing procedures for osteopathic physicians.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

- 1 That §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted
- 2 to read as follows:

# ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

#### §64-9-1. Board of Osteopathic Medicine.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 26, 2016, authorized under the
- 2 authority of section three, article three-e, chapter thirty of this code, modified by the Board of
- 3 Osteopathic Medicine to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee
- 4 and refiled in the State Register on September 29, 2016, relating to the Board of Osteopathic
- 5 Medicine (Licensing Procedures for Osteopathic Physicians, 24 CSR 01), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Osteopathic Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Licensing Procedures for Osteopathic Physicians.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
