Introduced SB 265 2017R1394

A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
designated §17C-15-51, relating to requiring motor vehicles, trailers or semitrailers having
a hydraulically operated bed to have a warning device that will alert the operator when the
vehicle is in motion and the bed is in an upward position; and requiring rulemaking.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated §17C-15-51, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 15. EQUIPMENT.

§17C-15-51. Hydraulic lift warning device.

- (a) On or before January 1, 2018 every motor vehicle, truck, trailer or semitrailer having a
 hydraulically operated bed shall include a warning device that will alert the driver in the event the
 bed is in an upward position when the vehicle is in motion.
- (b) The Commissioner of the Division of Motor Vehicles shall propose rules for legislative
 approval in accordance with article three, chapter twenty-nine-a of the code to implement this
 section.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require motor vehicles, trailers or semitrailers having a hydraulically operated bed have a warning device that will alert the operator when the vehicle is in motion and the bed is in an upward position. The bill requires rule-making.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
