- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-8-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to directing Office of Administrative Hearings to amend and promulgate a current
- 3 legislative rule relating to appeal procedures.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

- 1 That §64-8-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted
- 2 to read as follows:

ARTICLE 8. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-8-1. Office of Administrative Hearings.

- 1 The Legislature directs the Office of Administrative Hearings, pursuant to the authority
- 2 given to the office in section four-a, article five-c, chapter seventeen-c of this code, to promulgate
- 3 the legislative rule filed in the State Register by the Office of Administrative Hearings on March
- 4 23, 2016, relating to appeal procedures (105 CSR 1), with the amendment set forth below:
- 5 On page fifteen, subsection 16.3 by striking out subdivision 16.3.a;
- 6 And, by renumbering the remaining subdivisions.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to direct the Office of Administrative Hearings to amend and promulgate a current legislative rule relating to its appeal procedures.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
