### **House Bill 4362**

1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new article,  
2 designated §18-2-41, relating to recognizing outstanding students who are top achievers  
3 in scholastic studies.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 2. STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION.**

**§18-2-41. Recognition of outstanding students.**

1 The board is authorized to develop a program relating to recognizing outstanding students  
2 in mathematics, science, history, English and their respective subcategories whose scores, based  
3 on state administered achievement tests, are in the top 10 of all students in the state for each  
4 grade level. These students shall receive recognition as being “All State” students in their  
5 respective scholastic categories. The program is to be implemented no later than July 1, 2018.

NOTE: The purpose of this to relating to recognizing outstanding students who are top achievers in scholastic studies.
