A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
designated §9-2-14, relating generally to benefits provided by the Department of Health
and Human Resources; requiring benefit access devices to have a photograph of the
person to whom a device was issued; permitting a benefit access device to be used by
another authorized individual on the device holder's behalf; defining terms; and providing
for rule-making.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

# ARTICLE 2. COMMISSIONER OF HUMAN SERVICES; POWERS, DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES GENERALLY.

#### §9-2-14. Benefit access device; photograph; who may use; definitions; rule-making.

- 1 (a) For the purposes of this section:
- 2 <u>"Benefits" means any payment, allotments, money, goods or other things of value granted</u>
- 3 pursuant to a benefit program.
- 4 <u>"Benefit access device" means any card, plate, account number or other means of access</u>
- 5 that can be used, alone or in conjunction with another access device, to obtain payments,
- 6 allotments, benefits, money, goods or other things of value that can be used to initiate a transfer
- 7 <u>of funds.</u>
- 8 <u>"Benefit program" includes the Federal Food Stamp Act, Supplemental Nutritional</u>
- 9 Assistance Program, Temporary Assistance to Needy Families, other similar state or federal
- 10 <u>financial assistance program or other program sponsored by the department.</u>

11 (b) All benefit access devices that permit access to benefits or a benefit program shall

- 12 have a photograph of the person to whom the device was issued.
- 13 (c) A benefit access device may also be used by another authorized individual, such as a
- 14 <u>caregiver, who may, with proper photo identification, use the device for the device holder's benefit.</u>

- 15 (d) The secretary shall propose rules in accordance with §29A-3-1 et seq. of this code that
- 16 are necessary to effectuate the requirements and purposes of this section by September 30,
- 17 <u>2018.</u>

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require benefit access devices to have a photograph of the person to whom a device was issued. The bill permits a benefit access device to be used by another authorized individual on the device holder's behalf. The bill defines terms and provides for rule-making.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
