1	A BILL supplementing and amending Chapter 31, Acts of the Legislature, Regular Session, 2019,
2	known as the Budget Bill, by supplementing and amending the appropriation for the fiscal
3	year ending June 30, 2020.
4	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
5	That Chapter 31, Acts of the Legislature, Regular Session, 2019, known as the budget
6	bill, be supplemented and amended by creating Title II, section 9 for the fiscal year ending June
7	30, 2020, to read as follows:
8	Sec. 9. Appropriations from general revenue fund surplus accrued. — The following item is
9	hereby appropriated from the state fund, general revenue, and is to be available for expenditure
10	during the fiscal year 2020 out of surplus funds only, accrued from the fiscal year ending June 30,
11	2019, subject to the terms and conditions set forth in this section.
12	It is the intent and mandate of the Legislature that the following appropriation be payable
13	only from surplus as of July 31, 2019 from the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, only after first
14	meeting requirements of W.Va. Code §11B-2-20(b) of this code.
15	In the event that surplus revenues available on July 31, 2019, are not sufficient to meet
16	the appropriation made pursuant to this section, then the appropriation shall be made to the extent
17	that surplus funds are available as of the date mandated to meet the appropriation in this section
18	and shall be allocated first to provide the necessary funds to meet the first appropriation of this
19	section and each subsequent appropriation in the order listed in this section.
