6	Whereas, The Governor has established that there now remains an unappropriated		
7	balance in the Department of Health and Human Resources, Division of Health - Central Office,		
8	fund 0407, fiscal year 2019, organization 0506, that is available for expenditure during the fiscal		
9	year ending June 30, 2019, which is hereby appropriated by the terms of this supplementary		
10	appropriation bill; therefore		
11	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:		
12	That the total appropriation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, to fund 0407, fiscal		
13	year 2019, organization 0506, be supplemented and amended by increasing an existing item of		
14	appropriation as follows:
