1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
2 designated §16-13A-9b, relating to public service districts' laying of water or sewer lines
3 on state rights-of-way; limiting the onsite time required supervision by a state engineer;
4 and requiring payment and performance bonds to cover a reasonable length of time for
5 defects to be discovered.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 13A. PUBLIC SERVICE DISTRICTS.

§16-13A-9b. Supervision of laying of lines on state rights-of-way limited.

1 When a public service district lays water lines, sewer lines, utilities or pipelines on state
2 rights-of-way, the state may require a state engineer to inspect the project at its commencement,
3 periodically and at its conclusion. The state may not require a public service district to have an
4 on-site state engineer for the entire time the project is under construction. The public service
5 district shall require payment and performance bonds to cover a reasonable length of time for
6 defects to be discovered.
