A BILL to amend and reenact §62-7-10 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended; and to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section designated §62-7-10a, all relating to the requiring a form of a certified commitment order to the Division of Corrections and Rehabilitation; requiring a form for commitments to prisons; requiring a form for commitments from magistrate or circuit courts to jails; clarifying the costs of incarceration; and clarifying the method of transmittal of commitment orders.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

CHAPTER 62. CRIMINAL PROCEDURE.

ARTICLE 7. EXECUTION OF SENTENCES; STAYS.
