- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- to authorizing the Treasurer's Office to promulgate a legislative rule relating to reporting
- 3 and claiming unknown and unlocatable interest owners reserved interests.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. Treasurer's Office.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 27, 2018, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §37B-2-7 of this code, modified by the Treasurer's Office to meet the objections of the
- 3 Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on December 13,
- 4 2018, relating to the Treasurer's Office (reporting and claiming unknown and unlocatable interest
- 5 owners reserved interests, 112 CSR 16), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Treasurer's Office to promulgate a legislative rule relating to reporting and claiming unknown and unlocatable interest owners reserved interests.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
