- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-10-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- to authorizing the Office of Miners' Health, Safety, and Training to promulgate a legislative
- 3 rule relating to rules for operating diesel equipment in underground mines in West Virginia.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

# ARTICLE 10. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

#### §64-56-1. Office of Miners' Health, Safety, and Training.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 25, 2018, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §22A-2A-308 of this code, relating to the Office of Miners' Health, Safety, and Training
- 3 (rules for operating diesel equipment in underground mines in West Virginia, 56 CSR 23), is
- 4 authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Office of Miners' Health, Safety, and Training to promulgate a legislative rule relating to rules for operating diesel equipment in underground mines in West Virginia.
