Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 20E. WEST VIRGINIA MEDICAL PROFESSIONAL LIABILITY INSURANCE

JOINT UNDERWRITING ASSOCIATION ACT.

§1. Repeal of article creating West Virginia Medical Professional Liability Insurance Joint

Underwriting Association Act.

1 That §33-20E-1 through §33-20E-21 of the Code of West Virginia are repealed.

ARTICLE 20F. PHYSICIANS' MUTUAL INSURANCE COMPANY.

§2. Repeal of article creating Physicians' Mutual Insurance Company Act.

1 That §33-20F-1 through §33-20F-12 of the Code of West Virginia are repealed.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to repeal obsolete provisions of Code formerly enacted for the initial formation and operation of the West Virginia Medical Professional Liability Insurance Joint Underwriting Association and the West Virginia Physicians Mutual Insurance Company.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
