1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,  
2 designated §8-6-7, relating to defining the term “minor boundary adjustment” as it applies  
3 to municipal annexations.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 6. ANNEXATION.**

**§8-6-7. Definition of “minor boundary adjustment”.**

1 As used in this article, “minor boundary adjustment” means 10 percent or less of the  
2 existing acreage of the municipality.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to define the term “minor boundary adjustment” as applied to municipal annexations.
