Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

# ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

#### §64-9-1. Board of Medicine.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 25, 2018, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §30-3-7 of this code, relating to the Board of Medicine (permitting and disciplinary
- 3 procedures: educational permits for graduate medical interns, residents, and fellows, 11 CSR 12),
- 4 is authorized.
