- 1 A BILL to repeal §61-3-39I of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to requiring
- 2 printing the date a consumer deposit account was opened on paper check.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**§61-3-39I. Checks on consumer deposit accounts to show date account was opened;
consumer deposit account defined.**

- 1 [Repealed.]

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to repeal requiring printing the date a consumer deposit account was opened on paper checks.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
