1 A BILL to amend and reenact §18-4-4 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
2 to placing a limit on the salary of a county superintendent of schools.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 4. COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS.**

**§18-4-4. Compensation.**

1 On or before June 1 of the year in which the superintendent is appointed, the board shall  
2 fix the annual salary of the superintendent for the period of appointment for the term beginning on  
3 the following July 1. The board shall pay the salary from the general current expense fund of the  
4 district. The salary of any superintendent may not exceed \$130,000.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to cap the salary of a county superintendent of schools at \$130,000.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
