1 A BILL to repeal §33-25G-1, §33-25G-2, §33-25G-3, §33-25G-4, and §33-25G-5 of the Code of
2 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, all relating to Provider Sponsored Networks.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 25G. PROVIDER SPONSORED NETWORKS.

§1 Repeal of article creating Provider Sponsored Networks.

1 That §33-25G-1 through §33-25G-5 of the code of West Virginia are repealed.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to repeal the article providing for Provider Sponsored Networks.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
