1 A BILL to repeal §23-2-1d of the Code of West Virginia,1931, as amended, relating to prime

2 contractors liability for subcontractors failure to make proper payments for workers'

3 compensation coverage.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 2. EMPLOYERS AND EMPLOYEES SUBJECT TO CHAPTER; EXTRATERRITORIAL COVERAGE.

§23-2-1d. Prime contractors and subcontractors liability.

[Repealed]

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to repeal the law which makes prime contractors liable for the failure of subcontractors to make proper payments for workers' compensation coverage.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
