- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
- 2 designated §16-9A-11, relating to the posting of information regarding the West Virginia
- 3 Tobacco Quitline.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 9A. TOBACCO USAGE RESTRICTIONS.

§16-9A-11. Posting of West Virginia Tobacco Quitline information by retailers.

- 1 <u>Any retailer furnishing tobacco, tobacco related products, alternative nicotine products, or</u>
- 2 vapor products, pursuant to §11-12-1 et seq. of this code shall post signage for the West Virginia
- 3 <u>Tobacco Quitline in their place of business.</u>

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require the tobacco quit line to be posted at certain locations.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
