1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
2 designated §17-4-56, relating to requiring the Commissioner of Highways to include
3 rumble strips on construction projects involving two lane secondary roads.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 4. STATE ROAD SYSTEM.

§17-4-56. Rumble strips required on new secondary road projects.

1 On all new construction projects involving two lane secondary roads, the commissioner
2 shall require the placement of rumble strips at the center of the road, changing the noise a
3 vehicle's tires make on the surface and so that drivers are warned of crossing the center line of
4 the road.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require the Commissioner of Highways to include rumble strips on construction projects involving two lane secondary roads.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
