- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
- 2 designated §18-2-25c, relating to requiring students to compete only against students of
- 3 the same biological gender in any athletic contests or competitions in public schools.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 2. STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION.

§18-2-25c. Athletic contests or competitions based upon biological gender.

- 1 <u>Every athletic contest or competition, including training and practice competitions, at any</u>
- 2 grade level at any public school, whether the competition be in-class, intramural, or
- 3 interscholastic, shall be structured so that only students of the same biological gender shall
- 4 compete against each other. For purposes of this section, biological gender means the gender of
- 5 the student as determined at the time of birth and recorded on the student's birth certificate.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require students to compete only against students of the same biological gender in any athletic contests or competitions in public schools.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
