1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
2 designated §3-4A-35, relating to requiring the Secretary of State and the West Virginia
3 Cybersecurity Office to run or use a penetration test for online election systems no later
4 than one month before all elections.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 4A. ELECTRONIC VOTING SYSTEMS.

§3-4A-35. Penetration test for online election systems.

1 The Secretary of State, in coordination with the West Virginia Cybersecurity Office, shall
2 run or use a penetration test for online election systems no later than one month before all
3 elections.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require the Secretary of State and the West Virginia Cybersecurity Office to run a penetration test for online election systems no later than one month before all elections.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
