1 A BILL expiring funds to the balance of the Department of Transportation, State Rail Authority,
2 West Virginia Commuter Rail Access Fund, fund 8402, fiscal year 2020, organization 0804
3 in the amount of \$750,000, all from the Auditor's Office – Purchasing Card Administration
4 Fund, fund 1234, fiscal year 2020, organization 1200, by supplementing and amending
5 chapter 31, Acts of the Legislature, 2019, known as the Budget Bill.

1 Whereas, The Legislature finds that the account balance in the Auditor's Office –
2 Purchasing Card Administration Fund, fund 1234, fiscal year 2020, organization 1200 exceeds
3 that which is necessary for the purpose for which the account was established; therefore

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

1 That the balance of funds available for expenditure in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020,
2 to the Auditor's Office – Purchasing Card Administration Fund, fund 1234, fiscal year 2020,
3 organization 1200, be decreased by expiring the amount of \$750,000 to the Department of
4 Transportation, State Rail Authority, West Virginia Commuter Rail Access Fund, fund 8402, fiscal
5 year 2020, organization 0804.
