## **Senate Bill 272**

[Introduced January 10, 2020; referred  
to the Committee on the Judiciary]

1 A BILL to repeal §61-3-36 and §61-3-46 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended; and to  
 2 repeal §61-8-25 of said code, relating to arcane criminalized conduct.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 3. CRIMES AGAINST PROPERTY.**

**§61-3-36. Anchoring or beaching shanty boats on lands of another; penalties.**

1 [Repealed.]

**§61-3-46. Use of slugs, false coins, etc., in coin-box telephone; penalty.**

**ARTICLE 8. CRIMES AGAINST CHASTITY, MORALITY AND DECENCY.**

**§61-8-25. Requiring children to beg, sing or play musical instruments in streets; penalty.**

1 [Repealed.]

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to repeal misdemeanor offenses that relate to criminalized conduct and are considered arcane.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
