## **Senate Bill 353**

1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-5-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
 2 to authorizing the Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative  
 3 rule relating to pilot program for drug screening of applicants for cash assistance.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN  
 RESOURCES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-5-1. Department of Health and Human Resources.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on September 4, 2019, authorized under the  
 2 authority of §9-3-6(n) of this code, relating to the Department of Health and Human Resources  
 3 (pilot program for drug screening of applicants for cash assistance, [78 CSR 26](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative rule relating to pilot program for drug screening of applicants for cash assistance.
