- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to authorizing the Board of Chiropractic Examiners to promulgate a legislative rule relating
- 3 to application for waiver of initial licensing fees for certain individuals.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. Board of Chiropractic Examiners.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 10, 2019, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §30-1-23 of this code, modified by the Board of Chiropractic Examiners to meet the
- 3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on
- 4 October 4, 2019, relating to the Board of Chiropractic Examiners (application for waiver of initial
- 5 licensing fees for certain individuals, 4 CSR 07), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Chiropractic Examiners to promulgate a legislative rule relating to application for waiver of initial licensing fees for certain individuals.
